The UPE Board of Directors is proud to announce the 6th annual United Public Employees Scholarship program. Open to the families of UPE members. The program offers four **\$1500 scholarships** to help with college expenses.

The scholarships are part of the Union's endeavor to give back to our members. UPE is committed to investing in our membership whether it is in the form of representation, negotiations, or member appreciation programs such as these scholarships.



Applications must be postmarked by **June 10, 2022**. As a part of the application, those applying must complete a minimum 500-word essay, include three letters of reference and transcripts.

Scholarship recipients will be awarded at the June 21, 2022 Board of Directors meeting.



UPE Scholarship 2022

To Be Eligible for Consideration you must meet all of the following qualifications:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Be the immediate relative of an active member of United Public Employees Union. Immediate relative is defined as: child, stepchild, nephew/niece, grandchild; and sibling.
- Active members of United Public Employees that are sponsoring an applicant must have one year or more of continuous membership in the Union.
- Only Union members are eligible to sponsor an applicant.
- Show proof by transcripts that you will be graduating from or have graduated from a high school in 2021. If you are already enrolled in college, you must submit college transcripts to prove your status.
- Provide an unofficial transcript to confirm the applicant has a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher by the time you submit your application.
- Show proof of enrollment or acceptance as a full-time undergraduate student in a two- or four-year college or university.
- Provide three letters of personal reference from people who know you and that are not related to you.
- Complete and submit the 500-word written essay.



500 Word Written Essay

Please write and submit a maximum 500-word essay that addresses one of the following topics:

- Please describe how overcoming adversity has helped shape who you are as a person.
- What kind of leadership role have you taken in your academic, volunteer, or community service activities?

This essay is very important. While a high-grade point average is always desirable, the lessons we learn from helping others can have profound effects on our future success in life. Please take some time to reflect on what you did, what it meant to you and those you served. Don't hold back. The committee is looking for a measure of your heart and wisdom as well as your academic achievements.

How To Apply

1. ***Fill out the application form completely.*** Each person you list as a personal reference must supply a written letter on your behalf and that letter must accompany the application.
2. Be sure to sign the application.
3. Make certain that you have all the requested documentation. The committee receives more applicants than we have available scholarships in a given year. ***We cannot consider your application for a scholarship if documentation is missing.***
